Eligibility

- 16 years of age or older
- Not enrolled or required to be enrolled in secondary school under Guam law
- Without a high school diploma or recognized equivalent
- Needing mastery of basic educational skills to function effectively in society
- Needing support in speaking, reading, or writing the English language to earn a high school diploma, prepare for college-level classes, or seek employment
- Complete health clearance requirements

Registration Materials

- Guam ID or passport and Social Security card
- Letter of withdrawal from last school attended (if 16-17 years old)
- Accompanied by parent or legal guardian (if 16-17)

Programs

Adult Basic Education (ABE)

Courses for adult learners needing to develop literacy and mathematics skills for citizenship, employment, and in preparation to take a high school equivalency exam.

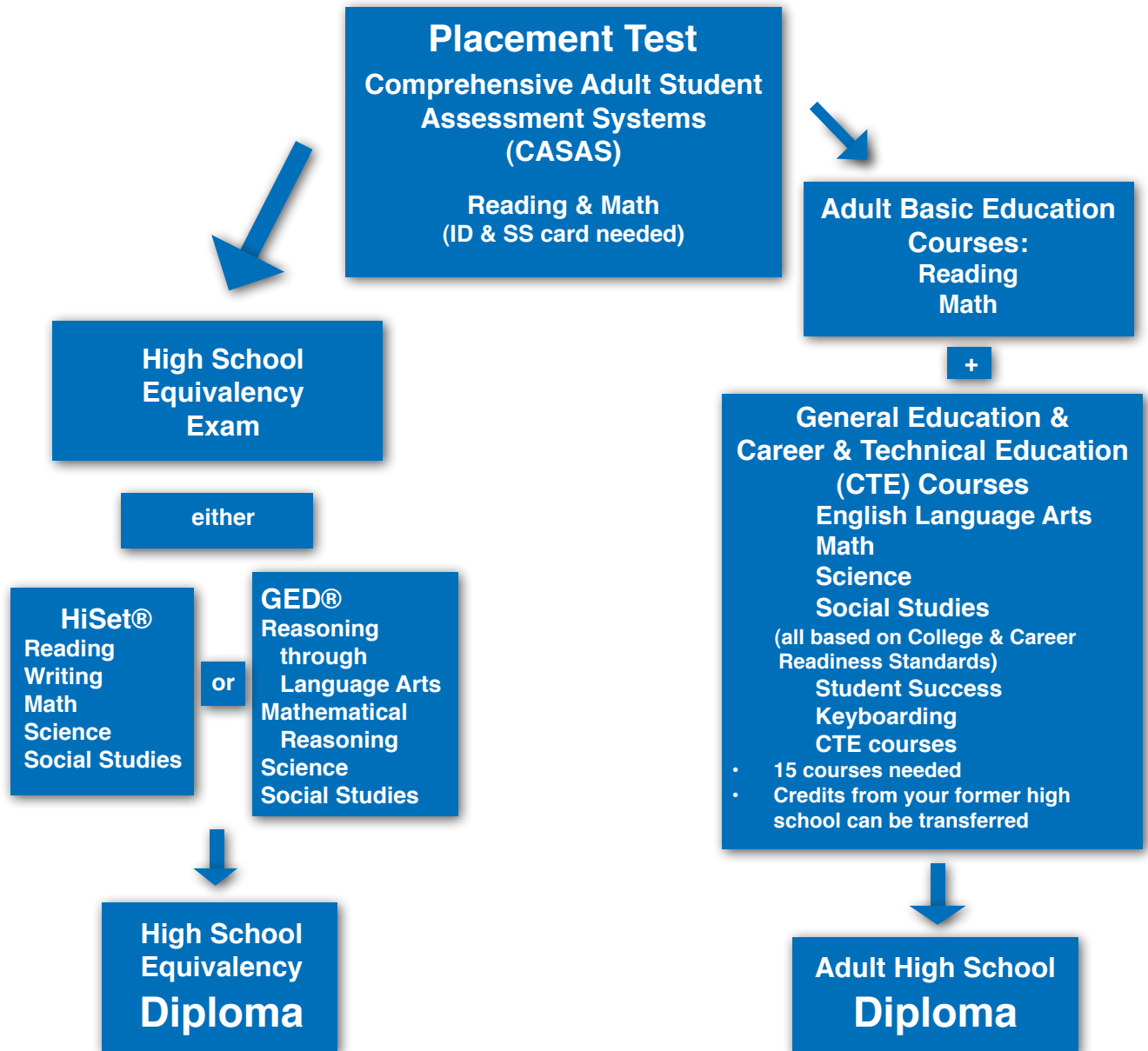
Adult High School (AHS)

General and career and technical education courses for adult learners to earn credits towards an Adult High School Diploma.

English as a Second Language (ESL)

Courses in speaking, reading, and writing English for those working towards a high school diploma or equivalency, those planning to take postsecondary classes, and those seeking employment.
