



**AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF UNIVERSITY WOMEN (AAUW) – GUAM BRANCH
SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

Scholarship Name: American Association of University Women (AAUW) – Guam Branch

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

1. Applicant must be a full-time student currently enrolled, pursuing an Associate's Degree at the Guam Community College (GCC) and must be an active member of the AAUW GCC Student Chapter.
2. Applicant has successfully completed a minimum of two (2) semesters at GCC.
3. Applicant must have at least a 2.5 cumulative grade point average (GPA).
4. Applicant must provide an official transcript to demonstrate current GPA.
5. Applicant must submit letters of recommendation from two (2) GCC faculty.
6. Applicant must submit a one-page (typed) essay on any of the following topics:
 - a. Cultural influences on gainful employment for women.
 - b. The employment of women in traditional male-dominated careers.
 - c. A current issue related to the AAUW Mission Statement
 - d. Barriers women in Guam encounter in reaching top positions.

AMOUNT AND NUMBER OF AWARDS: One (1) \$500 scholarships per academic year will be awarded to the top applicants.

METHOD OF PAYMENT: Selected applicant must show proof of GCC registration for Spring Semester 2017 to AAUW before payment is made to the selected GCC student(s).

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Application requirements must be submitted to the GCC Financial Aid Office no later than February 28, 2017.

SELECTION PROCESS: The AAUW Scholarship Committee will rate the applications based on the two letters of recommendations from two (2) GCC faculty, GPA (official transcripts), and one-page essay.
