MEMORANDUM

TO: All GCC Students

SUBJECT: Health Requirements for GCC Enrollment/Registration

The GCC Health Center supports the mission of the College through provision of first aid interventions in time of illness and injuries and health promotion measures which include the Tuberculosis and Immunization Programs geared towards the prevention of communicable diseases. To achieve these goals and to better serve you, the following data are needed:

1. Properly complete the Emergency Health Information form;
2. TB clearance within one year and;
3. An updated immunization record which includes:
 - a. Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR);
*at least one dose of MMR given on or after the first birthday (Guam Immunization protocol indicates that it is strongly recommended that individuals born on or after 1957 receive two doses of MMR if they have no documentation of two doses of MMR; if they never had measles (physician-diagnosed); or if they do not have confirmed laboratory evidence of measles immunity.)
*individuals born before 1957 are exempted from the MMR requirement.
 - b. Diphtheria, Pertussis, Tetanus (DPT) or Tetanus and Diphtheria (TD) must be current within the last ten years and; Polio Vaccine (OPV/IPV) if below 18 years of age.

If your choice of study will place you at risk for the exposure to blood borne pathogens, you are advised to follow further instructions by your respective program advisor regarding other health requirements such as Hepatitis B vaccinations and physical examination.
