Frequently Asked Questions

What is the youth apprenticeship program, and how does it work?

- The youth apprenticeship program offers handson learning in the hospitality and tourism industry for high school students. Students are hired as apprentices working part-time with hotel apprenticeship sponsors while continuing their education.

What are the benefits of my child participating in this program?

- Your child will earn wages and gain real-world experience, industry mentorship, and a head start on a fulfilling career in hospitality and tourism. Wrap-around services such as counseling, tutoring, and other support services can be made available from our program sponsors.

How will my child's regular schoolwork be affected by the apprenticeship program?

- We ensure a balanced schedule, and apprentices receive academic support to manage both their schoolwork and apprenticeship.

What is the commitment required from both the student and the parent?

- Students commit to part-time work, and parents support their child's education, commitment to the apprenticeship, and reliable transportation.

How soon can my child enroll in the Hotel Associate Youth Apprenticeship Program?

- Students meeting the eligibility requirements and follow the enrollment criteria can be hired immediately by participating hotel apprenticeship sponsors.

Enrollment Criteria

- Must be enrolled in the Hospitality and Tourism Management Program and in good academic standing.
- Complete the apprenticeship application packet.
- Complete a job application and the interview process with participating hotel apprenticeship sponsors.
- Parents/Guardians must guarantee transportation to and from hotel properties.

Apprenticeship Offers More Than Internship

Internship

- Unpaid work experience.
- Exposure to real-world work environments.
- While internships are unpaid, they offer invaluable insights into specific industries, allowing students to explore their interests.

Apprenticeship:

- Paid employment with wage progression opportunities based on performance.
- Apprenticeships provide extended training, leading to a Department of Labor journeymen workers certificate and a GCC postsecondary AS in International Hotel Management. This program is industry-driven, approved by the Guam Department of Labor

Dual Credits:

Both offer the chance to earn credits simultaneously towards high school graduation and a GCC certificate of mastery.
