Selection is based primarily on materials submitted by a nominator. The selection committee will consider the nominee's professional accomplishments; professional activities; demonstration of distinct/unique achievement in their career since graduation; student achievements; and, national recognitions as part of the criteria for selection.

The Distinguished Alumni Award helps the college to reconnect with its over 10,000 alumni, promote special events, and move forward with GCC initiatives.
