Of the 22 completers, 13 are from the Diesel Mechanic I boot camp with courses like Introduction to Diesel Tech and Preventative Maintenance I and Diesel Tech and Preventative Maintenance II, Diesel Engines I.

The Construction III boot camp is fully funded by the Department of Interior's Technical Assistance Program Grant awarded to GCC. There were a total of nine completers and they have all completed courses relative to the industry; Introduction to Carpentry, Electricity Level 1, and Refrigeration and Air Conditioning Level 1. In addition to these courses, students will also receive their certification to provide Basic First Aid and Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) with an automated defibrillator (AED).
