Campus Safety Tips



SAFE KEEP YOUR BELONGINGS

Do not leave belongings unattended and ensure your car doors are locked when leaving or while inside.



WALK WITH A BUDDY

Avoid walking alone at night and stay in well-lit, well-populated areas. Take the safest route, not the fastest route.



STAY AWARE OF YOUR SURROUNDINGS

When crossing streets or navigating construction zones, avoid distractions. While driving on campus, maintain a safe speed and watch for pedestrians.



PERSONAL INFORMATION

Shred or properly dispose of trash with personal information. Do not share login details. Enable 2FA or Multi-Factor Authentication for enhanced digital security.



REFRAIN FROM PETTING/FEEDING VISITING ANIMALS

Close contact with animals can pose risks, as they may become startled or exhibit aggressive behavior.



FAMILIARIZE YOURSELF WITH THE CAMPUS AND ITS EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

Be aware of the designated evacuation routes in buildings for emergency situations, and take the time to familiarize yourself with the campus emergency procedures.
