ANNOUNCEMENT

RFC Program Eligibility Criteria

1. **First Generation Student**—Neither parent holds a bachelor's degree or beyond;
2. **Low-Income**—According to the U.S. Department of Education guidelines OR if a student is part of the free/reduced lunch program;
3. **Student with a Disability**—Documentation required;
4. **At-Risk**—Student experiencing one or more of the following factors in their life: single parent home (including household where a parent is deployed), non-traditional home environment (e.g. living with grandparents, uncle/aunt in household), at or below the poverty line, poor performance at school, emotionally or physically abused, few support systems, neglect or abandonment, and sometimes negative contact with police agencies
