Printing: Do You Have To?

Employees leave approximately 35 percent of their print jobs in the copy rooms. This significant waste of paper and toner also results in needless carbon dioxide (CO₂) emissions from printers.

It is recommended that you:

- · Print on both sides or print more than one page or slide per side of paper.
- Use black and white instead of color. Using any color on the page, including logos or accent lines, incurs a color-usage cost, which is approximately 8.5 times more expensive than black and white.
- Instead of sending physical copies for meetings, share your document by sending a link.
 Attendees can view it on their laptops.
- Connect your laptop to the meeting room projector and display the document electronically.
