

Financial Aid Rights and Responsibilities

As a Financial Aid applicant, you have the right to:

- ◆ Be informed about financial aid application procedures, cost of attendance, aid availability and renewal requirements.
- Confidential protection of your financial aid records. The contents of your file are maintained in accordance with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA).

On the other hand, you have the responsibility to:

- Complete applications accurately and on time.
- Read and understand all materials sent to you from the financial aid section and other agencies.
- Keep copies of all forms and materials submitted.
- Know and comply with the rules governing your aid programs.
- Comply with the provisions of any agreements you sign.
- Inform GCC's Financial Aid Office of any previously unreported financial assistance from non-GCC sources.
- Maintain satisfactory academic progress.
- ◆ Request assistance if you have questions or don't understand the information provided to you.
- Use the award for school expenses, including tuition and fees, room and board, books and supplies and transportation.
