ASSOCIATE OF SCIENCE IN PRACTICAL NURSING

The Associate of Science in Practical Nursing 2024-2025 cohort, which graduated on May 8, 2025, currently has a 30% first-write pass rate, with eight out of 27 students having taken the NCLEX-PN exam. The remaining students are preparing to take their licensing exam, and are anticipated to do so before the end of the year.

The 2025 fall semester began on August 15, 2025, with 20 students who were accepted into the 2025-2026 ASPN cohort. The program began with NU110 Nursing Foundations & Basic Skills and NU160 Pharmacology for Practical Nurses. On September 15, 2025, the students began their first clinical rotations for NU110 at the Guam Memorial Hospital Skilled Nursing Unit. In an effort to support the patients they are assigned to the students have developed games and activities to enhance their patients' mental health and cognitive stimulation.

The Nursing and Allied Health Department continues to seek qualified adjunct faculty to instruct the laboratory and clinical components of NU-level courses required for the program.
