GCC Basic Project Management training to start Feb. 8

Guam Community College's Basic Project Management course will be offered from February 8 – March 15 for professionals who need a project management credential on their resume. The BPM course provides a basic overview of projects and managing projects in private and public sectors, covering the stages of projects and the functional areas of project management, including project planning, managing, control and wrap up. The course will review the functional areas of expertise required by the project manager, as well as the roles and responsibilities of project team members.

GCC's BPM course also provides the number of contact hours required to take the PMI Certified Associate in Project Management (CAPM). For persons with project management experience, the course provides the contact hours required to take the PMI Project Management Professional (PMP) exam. Project Management certification is an increasingly valuable credential, because local and off-island companies are looking for people to manage projects in every field.
