GCC to host annual Math Kangaroo March 21

The Guam Community College Math Department will host the island's 15th annual Math Kangaroo on Friday, March 21, from 9:45 A.M. – 1:30 P.M. on the GCC campus. The Math Kangaroo is a nationwide math test for grades 1-12. Approximately 200 students from public and private schools will attend Guam's Math Kangaroo at GCC.

The Math Kangaroo test will take place from 9:45-11:15 A.M in the AALG Allied Health Center. Afterward, the students will participate in a Math Carnival in the courtyard at the GCC Student Center until 1:30 P.M. The various GCC programs will have booths set up at the carnival, providing games, demonstrations, and hands-on activities for students of all grade ranges so that they can learn about the fields of study offered at GCC, and about how math is applied in these programs and in other fields.
