The STEER will take place from December 27, 2016 through January 6, 2017, in the GCC Student Center Training Room.

"This year's STEER is focusing on sustainable homes," according to Francisco "Kiko" Palacios, GCC Sustainability Coordinator and STEER director.

"The students will be building miniature sustainable home models, with moving parts, and we will have a competition and showcase on the last day," Palacios said. "I'm excited to see the designs they will come up with, because this young generation is very creative and innovative, and they're learning how to be much more environmentally conscious than previous generations," he added.
