The 2020 Census of Guam is seeking qualified individuals who are looking for an opportunity to participate in the island wide population count!

We are recruiting for a variety of temporary full and part-time positions that extend into summer 2020.

Interested applicants should be highly motivated, friendly, and possess the following minimum qualifications:

- Be at least 18 years old
- Be a U.S. citizen or eligible to work on Guam
- Possess a valid social security number
- Possess a high school diploma or GED
- Pass an FBI background check
- Pass a personal interview and written assessment exam

Field Operations Supervisor

\$20.08 per hour

Assists in the creation of geographic assignment areas used to conduct data collection. Coordinates and oversees the data collection from every household in that geographic area from initial assignment through completion.

This position also supervises a Crew Leader and their team of Enumerators as they interview and collect responses from members of the community.

This position is full-time.

Office Clerk

\$13.57 per hour

Assists in coordination of data collection assignments, including the preparation and distribution of geographic assignment materials, data entry, and filing.

Conducts the check-in of data collection materials and performs clerical review, and other clerical activities.

This position is full-time.

Crew Leader

\$19.36 per hour

Supervises a team of up to six Enumerators and oversees data collection activities out in the community. Performs quality checks for all data collection materials and provides daily reports to the Field Operations Supervisor.

This position may be full or part-time.

Crew Leader Assistant

\$18.64 per hour

Assists the Crew Leader in data collection, performing quality checks, and daily reporting of all data collection activities.

This position is part-time.

Enumerator

\$18.64 per hour

Performs the data collection in the community, including listing all housing structures and addressees and conducting in-person interviews.

This position is part-time.
